The month of June marks the coming of summer as we direct our attentions to the National Concern Collection – the weekend of June 15 & 16, 2019. The Collection provides funding for five Catholic initiatives that touch the faithful of Wisconsin as well as throughout the United States. Your generosity and prayers support the following appeals:

The National Retirement Fund for Religious maintains vital funding for our sisters and all religious institutes in need. Today many senior religious continue to manifest God’s love and generosity by serving in a wide range of volunteer activities.

The Catholic Communication Campaign focuses on finding new ways to deliver the gospel message to people in today’s digital age – on the internet to strengthen marriage, in podcasts for daily readings, on television for Christmas Mass and on Facebook for sharing the Faith. Fifty percent of the collection supports local communication efforts.

The Catholic Campaign for Human Development, working via the Diocesan Department of Stewardship and Development, provides national grants that make a difference in low-income communities to fund programs addressing the very root causes of poverty.
